THIS MATTER having been brought to the Court upon the Motion of St. Mary's Hospital, Passaic, N.J., the debtor and debtor-in-possession herein ("St. Mary's," "SMH" or the "Debtor"),¹ by and through its proposed counsel, Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, LLP, upon motion for entry of an Order (I) Authorizing the Payment of Various Pre-Petition Amounts to Non-Employee Physicians and (II) Granting Related Relief (the "Motion"); and the Court having considered the Application submitted in support of the Motion; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Motion; and the Court having determined that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor and the Debtor's estate; and it appearing that due and appropriate notice of the Motion has been provided; and after due deliberation and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, as follows:

1. The Debtor is authorized to immediately issue or re-issue the following types of checks to non-employee physicians identified in the Motion for pre-petition services: Bounced Checks, On-Call and Pre-Petition Services Checks, Aetna Reimbursement Checks and UMDNJ Checks.
2. The Debtor is also authorized, subject to its business judgment and subject to

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appropriate budgeting in relevant cash collateral or financing orders, to pay non-employee physicians for pre-petition services which are not addressed in the Motion but which become known to the Debtor following entry of this Order (hereinafter, the “Supplemental Payments”). The Debtor shall file with the Court a Notice listing such Supplemental Payments, and serve such Notice pursuant to the Notice, Case Management, and Administrative Procedures Order approved by the Court on June 1, 2009. If no objections are filed to such Notice of Supplemental Payments within five (5) business days after service thereof, then the Supplemental Payments shall be deemed approved without the necessity of a hearing or entry of a further Order by this Court.

3. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to constitute an assumption of any agreements with any non-employee physicians serving the Debtor and/or the Debtor’s patients.

4. The Debtor’s counsel shall serve a copy of this Order on all Notice Parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
